Q&A

We welcome the questions that have been recently pouring in!

Q: What hotel are you staying at in Fort Lauderdale?

A: Residence Inn Fort Lauderdale Intracoastal Il Lugano. We have a block of rooms with special pricing for our group. The rate is good for 3 nights, Wednesday/Thursday/Friday. If you book just Friday night, you can do so by clicking [here](#) and doing it through our special website. If you want to book more than one night, you will need to call our rep, Talia, at this number: [954-226-5105](#). There are two room categories to chose from, One Bedroom Suite \$209 or Executive Studio \$179.

Q: Should we invest in the all inclusive drink package?

A: It's completely up to you. Drinking on a ship can get costly if you plan on having a mimosa for breakfast, a couple drinks by the pool, cooling off with a beer or two at lunch, some wine at dinner, and a couple more drinks at the comedy show. Add those up with bottles of water throughout the day and you can be accruing quite the beverage tab. If you're able to get the drink package at a 20% discounted rate in advance, feel free to scoop it up. Otherwise, wait until onboard so you can score a promotion. If you're considering getting the internet package, check out the combined internet and drink package. Not everyone in your stateroom is required to have it so if only one persons thinks it will be worth it, just that person can get it while the other can buy drinks al la carte. The drink package at the 20% discount plus service fees will run you about \$400/person.

Q: Are there any group activities planned for the island days?

A: No. We want you to have fun on your vacation without feeling like you are missing out on anything. Plan all the beach time, island exploring, and excursions that you'd like! We recommend reviewing excursions prior to the cruise and purchasing them in advance if you can, otherwise you could end up wasting a lot of time the day you get on the ship in line with thousands of other cruisers also trying to book their excursions.

Q: What is the deadline for paying my cruise balance?

A: Saturday, June 17th at 8:00pm. If your cruise isn't paid in full by this date, your reservation will be cancelled.

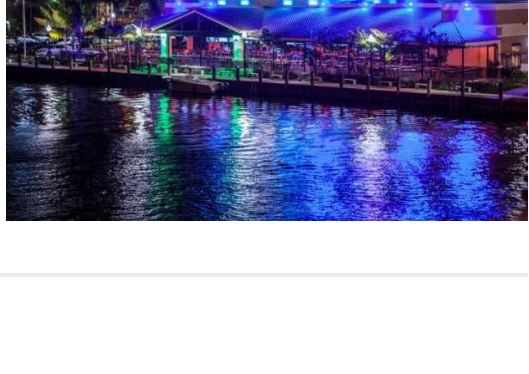
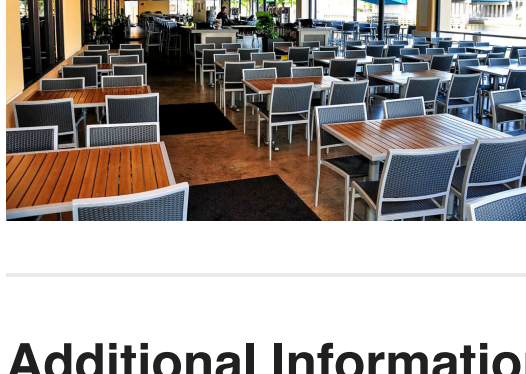
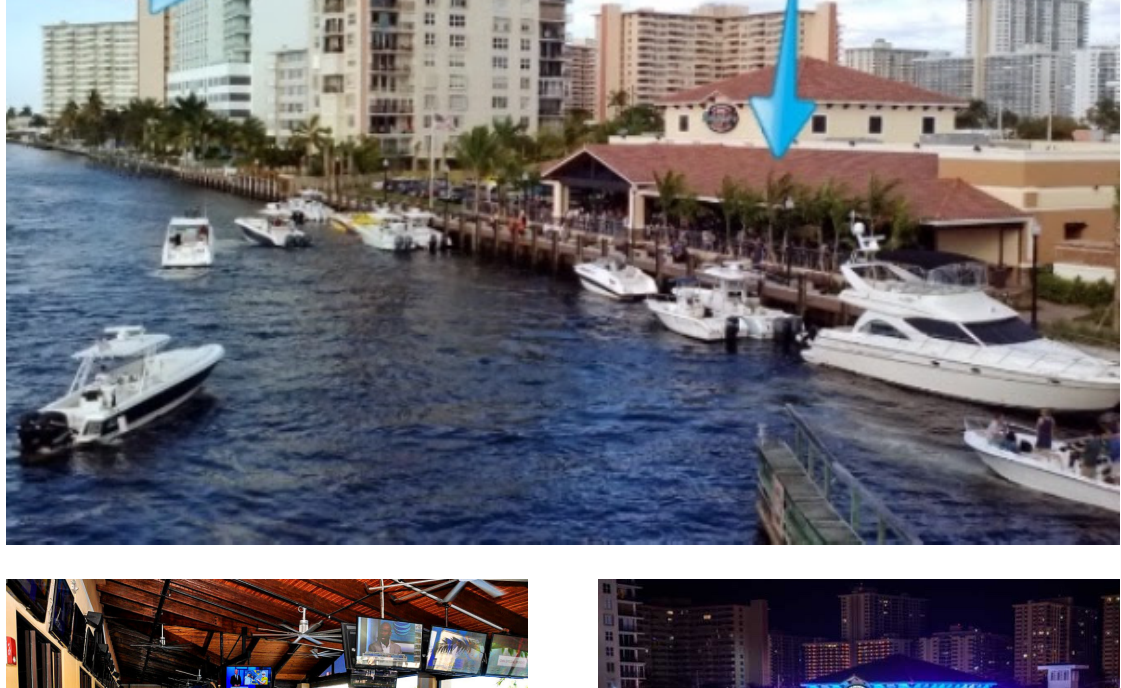
